**What the Official Notice Said**

The above petition has been approved. The petition indicates that the person for whom you are petitioning is in the United States and will apply for adjustment of status. He or she should contact the local USCIS office to obtain Form I-485, Application to Register Permanent Residence or Adjust Status. A copy of this notice should be submitted with the application, with appropriate fee, to this Service Center. Additional information about eligibility for adjustment of status may be obtained from the local USCIS office serving the area where he or she lives, or by calling 1-800-375-5283.

If the person for whom you are petitioning desires to apply for a visa outside the United States based on this petition, the petitioner should file Form I-324, Application for Alien on an Approved Application or Petition, to request that we send the petition to the Department of State National Visa Center (NVC).

The NVC processes all approved immigrant visa petitions that require consular action. The NVC also determines which consular post is the appropriate consulate to complete visa processing. It will then forward the approved petition to that consulate.

The approval of this Notice of Action does not in itself create any immigration status and does not guarantee that the alien beneficiary will subsequently be found to be eligible for a visa, for admission to the United States, or for an extension, change, or adjustment of status.


